The information on the Online Construction Reports Service is provided for the use of BXWI members to facilitate the bid process only. Replication other than for estimating purposes is strictly prohibited. BXWI reserves the right to control or limit access to the Online Construction Reports Service. **Each individual using the system must possess a uniquely assigned, licensed password. The sharing of a licensed password is prohibited.**

BXWI reserves the right to monitor all information stored in any files, programs, or messages, as well as the right to delete or edit any file, program, or message that contains, in their sole discretion, any obscene, abusive or otherwise objectionable language or material. *Access will be denied* to any individual or company who has made, or indicates use of the Online Construction Reports Service for improper purposes.

The Online Construction Reports Service contains information on construction projects, including availability, bidders and/or plan holders of record, and other pertinent information that may be required in the bid process for members of BXWI. Efforts have been made to assure the accuracy of the information reported, but BXWI offers no warranty, expressed or implied, that any of the reported information has total and complete accuracy. The best sources of information for project details are the bid documents, either maintained at the BXWI physical location or with the issuing authority.

BXWI expressly disclaims all warranties, including the warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose, in connection with the use or operation of the Online Construction Reports Service.

BXWI will not be liable for any losses, including lost data, information, profits or any other incidents of consequential damages that may be sustained or arise out of the use, operation or ability to use or operate the Online Construction Report Service. In consideration for the privilege of using the Online Construction Reports Service, subscribers hereby release the Builders Exchange of Wisconsin Inc., its officers, employees, and the Builders Exchange of Wisconsin web master from any and all claims arising from the use of this system.
